Thank you for speaking with me about your case. I am pleased that we were able to agree to a briefing schedule concerning this matter. As we discussed, that briefing schedule will be as follows:

- March 1, 2010 – Due date for Defendants' Answer or Motion to Dismiss
- March 29, 2010 – Due date for Plaintiff's Opposition ("Opp.")
- April 19, 2010 – Due date for Defendants' Reply

If the Court denies Defendants' Motion to Dismiss, Defendants will have 30 days from the date of that denial order to file their Answer. Once that Answer is filed, the following briefing schedule will apply:
