The matter came before the Court on the Verified Petition (“Petition”) by Patrick Canet (“Mr. Canet”), in his capacity as foreign representative (“Foreign Representative”) of the above captioned debtor, Gholam Reza Jazi Zandian (“Zandian” or “Debtor”), with liquidation proceedings in Paris, France, seeking entry of an order granting (a) recognition by this Court of the Foreign Representative as the Debtor’s foreign representative as that term is defined in 11 U.S.C. § 101(24), and (b) recognition of the French proceeding as a foreign main proceeding (“Foreign Proceeding”) pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 1515, 1517 and 1520. **DE 1.** Jeffrey Hartman appeared on behalf of the Foreign Representative; Jed Margolin (“Margolin”) was represented by Steven Ableman, who appeared by telephone and

1 Arthur Zorio who was present in the courtroom.

2 Hearing on in the Petition was originally set for June 23, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. **DE 6.**
3 On June 16, 2016, Margolin filed his Objection To Petition For Recognition And chapter 15
4 Relief (“Objection”). **DE 13.** The matter was continued until August 10, 2016 and in the
5 interim, the Foreign Representative was required to supplement the record with additional
6 materials. On August 3, 2016, the Foreign Representative filed his Status Report and Reply
7 Re: French Proceeding Against Zandian (“Reply”). **DE 18.** The August 10, 2016 hearing
8 was continued once again by a Stipulation. **DE 20.** Hearing on the merits was finally held
9 on September 6, 2016.

10 The Court has considered the Petition, the Objection, the Reply and the arguments of
11 counsel. In lieu of written findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Court stated its
12 findings of fact and conclusions of law on the record as permitted by F.R.Civ.P. 52 which is
13 made applicable to this proceeding by F.R.Bankr.P. 7052 and 9014(c). Good cause
14 appearing,

15 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Verified Petition for Recognition and Chapter 15 Relief
16 be, and the same hereby is, **Granted.**
